1. We will open our Miami space on the occasion of the first Monthly Gallery Walk on November 14, showing paintings of Jens Hausmann and the latest works of installation artist Kestutis Svirnelis, both based out of Berlin.
2. On December 3, the opening day of most of the art fairs, we will start presenting exiting works of young emerging artists originating from the vibrant melting pot of Berlin's art scene. Amongst them is Juliane Eirich, a young photographer who has recently been granted various awards and found her way into major collections and art magazine publications. "Berlin Next Generation", the title of this show, reflects both our mission and our conviction.

3. Our final exhibition "Stand der Dinge", opening January 9, 2010 will show latest works by Eamon O`Kane, Rebekka Brunke , Norbert Bauer, and Dominic Shepherd three well established positions of our galleries.
